IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS
CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 10 OF THE MINING ACT, 1989
I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER

Citation and
Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (Prospection for Gold, Valuable Minerals, Precious Stones, Precious Metals, Base Metals and Industrial Minerals) No. 1 Reservation Order 2002 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 16th July, 2002.

Reservation

2. The area hereinafter described in the schedule below are hereby reserved for Prospecting operations by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission; but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission.

SCHEDULE

A tract of state Land located in Mazaruni No.5, Cuyuni No.4, Northwest No.3 as shown on Topographic Sheets 3SE, 4SW, SE, 8NE, SE, 9NW, NE, SW, SE, 10SW, 15NE, SE, 16NW, NE, SW, SE, 17NW, SW and fully described as follows;

From a reference point located with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 6° 55' 41N, Longitude -60° 21' 54 thence at a true bearing of 248° for a distance of 9.32 mile(s) to point A with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 7° 40' 32N, Longitude -60° 35' 17 thence at a true bearing of 180° for a distance of

10.53 mile(s) to point B with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 7° 40' 11N, Longitude -60° 3' 21 thence at a true bearing of 90° for a distance of 40 mile(s) to point C with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 7° 29' 11N, Longitude -60° 3' 26 thence at a true bearing of 360° for a distance of 27.9 mile(s) to point D with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 7° 29' 25N, Longitude -60° 28' 35 thence at a true bearing of 270° for a distance of 18.4 mile(s) to point E with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 7° 23' 50, Longitude -60° 28' 42 thence at a true bearing of 313° for a distance of 27.2 mile(s) to point F with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 7° 7' 33N, Longitude -60° 11' 23 thence at a true bearing of 360° for a distance of 6.4 mile(s) to point G with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 7° 7' 32N, Longitude -59° 55' 16 thence at a true bearing of 90° for a distance of 28.7 mile(s) to point H with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 6° 43' 19N, Longitude -59° 55' 26thence at a true bearing of 360° for a distance of 12.7 mile(s) to point I with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 6° 43' 40N, Longitude -60° 30' 26 thence at a true bearing of 270° for a distance of 36.4 mile(s) to point J with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 6° 52' 51N, Longitude -60° 30' 22 thence along the Guyana/Venezuela border for a distance of 102 mile(s) to the point of commencement A, and enclosing an area of approx. 1,176,000 Acres, save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied.


