IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 10 OF THE MINING ACT, 1989 I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER

Citation and Commencement 1.

This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (Prospection for Gold, Valuable Minerals, Precious Stones, Precious Metals, Base Metals and Industrial Minerals) No. 1 Reservation Order 2002 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 16th July, 2002.

Reservation

The area hereinafter described in the schedule below are hereby reserved for Prospecting operations by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission; but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission.
