ORDER
Made Under
THE IMMIGRATION ACT
(Cap. 14:02)

UNDER SECTION 12(7) AND (8) OF THE IMMIGRATION ACT, IT IS HEREBY
ORDERED BY THE PRESIDENT AS FOLLOWS:-

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Free Movement of Persons) Order 2003.
- Free entry of persons. 2. A person mentioned in Part A of the Schedule to the Act who is a national of a country mentioned in Part B of the said Schedule shall be permitted by an immigration officer to enter and remain in Guyana either for a definite or indefinite period subject to the following conditions -
- (a) he must satisfy the requirement specified in the Immigration (Alternative to Passports) Order 1992 in relation to the production of his driver's licence or his identification card; or produce his passport to the immigration officer;
 - (b) he must produce evidence satisfactory to the immigration officer that he is a national of a country mentioned in Part B of the Schedule to the Act;
 - (c) he must inform the immigration officer of his intention to seek employment or to settle in Guyana.
- Amendment of Part A of the Schedule. 3. Part A of the Schedule to the Act is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph (b) thereof of the following as paragraph (bb) -
- “(bb) graduates of the University of Suriname;”
- Amendment of Part B of the Schedule. 4. Part B of the Schedule to the Act is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph 11 of the following as paragraph 11A -
- “11A. Suriname.”
- Revocation. 5. The Immigration (Graduates) Order, 1992 is hereby revoked.
