**THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT**

**(Chapter 62:05)**

**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 & 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: -**

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Sea Defence Works).
2. The proposed construction of Sea Defence works on the land described in the Schedule hereunder is hereby declared to be public work.
3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of it for the public work aforesaid.

**SCHEDULE**


Approximately one hundred and sixty-eight (168) acres of land PROFIT – FOULIS AREA, West Coast Berbice in County of Berbice Guyana and bounded as follows: -

- On the North:** Façade Drain (reserve) immediately South of the Atlantic Ocean;
- On the East:** by the Foulis/El dorado Sideline Dam
- On the South:** by the Public Road to Rosignol.
- On the West:** by The Abary River.

The aforesaid Land is shown on a plan prepared by the Guyana Lands and Surveys Commission, locate at 22 Upper Hadfield Street, Durban Backlands.
