

IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988 I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: -

- Citation.** 1. This Order may be cited as the National Industrial and Commercial Investment Limited (Vesting of Property) Order 2003.
- Interpretation.** 2. In this Order: -
- “NICIL” means National Industrial and Commercial Investments Limited, being a company incorporated in Guyana under the provisions of the Companies Act and continued under the Companies Act 1991 with its registered office situated at 126 Barrack and Parade Streets, Kingston, Georgetown, Demerara.

- Vesting of property.** 3. The immovable property of the State described in the Schedule is hereby vested in NICIL.

Sub-lot A, being part of the west half of the concession or lot numbered 126 (one hundred and twenty-six) situate in the Kingston District, in the city of Georgetown, in the county of Demerara, in the Republic of Guyana, the said sub-lot being laid down and defined on a plan by J.
