THE PRESIDENT'S COLLEGE ACT 1990
(No. 11 of 1990)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 22 OF THE PRESIDENT'S COLLEGE ACT 1990,
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Citation and
commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the National Schools (Board of Governors)
Order 2005 and shall come into operation on 1st July 2005.

Application of
certain provisions
of the Act.

2. (1) The provisions of the Act, other than sections 1, 2, 3(1), 10, 13 and
22 shall *mutatis mutandis* apply in relation to the educational institutions
mentioned in paragraph (3) and for that purpose shall be read and construed with
any necessary modifications, and, without prejudice to the generality of the
foregoing subject, in particular for the purpose of such application to the
modification in paragraph (4).

(2) Each of the educational institutions mentioned in paragraph (3) shall
be administered and maintained by a Board of Governors which shall be a body
corporate.


(4) The following is the modification referred to in paragraph (1) –

**"Vesting of
assets in Board
of Governors.**

13. The assets (whether movable or immovable property, including rights and interests) belonging to the State in relation to each of the schools to which this order applies are hereby vested in the Board of Governors of that school and the Registrar of Deeds shall accordingly make

the necessary annotations in his record in respect of the
aforesaid immovable property.”
