**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 10A OF THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-**


- Citation and commencement.      1.      This Order, which amends the Aerated Water Factories Wages Council Wages Regulation Order\*, may be cited as the Aerated Water Factories Wages Council Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order 2005, and shall come into force on 1 September 2005.
- Amendment of Principal Order.      2.      The Principal Order is amended by substituting for its Schedule the Schedule to this Order.
