**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 8 OF  
THE CUSTOMS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWIN ORDER:-**

Citation.

1. This Order, which amends the First Schedule to the Customs Act, may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order 2005.

Amendment of the  
First Schedule to  
the Principal Act.

2. The provisions of the First Schedule to the Principal Act mentioned in Column I of the Table are hereby amended as specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of the said Table –

Paragraph 4

Delete paragraph 4 including sub items 1 through 78

Insert new Paragraph 4 as follows:

“Materials which are not obtainable in Guyana, being not manufactured or produced therein, which are considered to be raw materials and packaging materials for use in the manufacture of goods by manufacturers and small businesses and in accordance with the published guidelines and/or regulations specific to the industry and approved by the Commissioner-General of GRA; and where the term ‘manufacturer’ or ‘small business’ is determined as those enterprises defined and registered under the Consumption Tax Act Chapter 80:02 and the Small Business Act 2004 respectively”.

Paragraph 11

Insert after “Government” the following words: “or in accordance with the published guidelines and/or regulations specific to the industry.”

(2) - FOR OTHER APPROVED PURPOSES

Paragraph 10 (1)

Delete Paragraph 10 (1)

Insert new Paragraph 10 (1) as follows:

“Goods imported by or for the use of the Guyana Red Cross, The St. John’s Ambulance Brigade, the Guyana Society for the Blind, the Salvation Army, and other approved charitable or non-profit organizations, in accordance with regulations and/or published guidelines.”

Paragraph 39

Delete sub paragraph 39 (g), 39 (h), 39 (i) and 39 (j)

Paragraph 45

Delete paragraph 45.

Paragraph 46, 47, 48 and 49

Renumber paragraphs 46, 47, 48, 49 as paragraphs 45, 46, 47, and 48 respectively.



<p>Paragraph 50</p>	<p>Delete sub paragraphs 50(a), 50(b), 50 (c), 50 (e), and 50 (f)</p> <p>Insert the following as paragraph 49 (a): Machinery and equipment for generating electricity from non-traditional sources (for example solar energy, bio-gas, windmills, and other similar equipment), providing that they are solely of a type used for household purposes only.</p> <p>Renumber paragraph 50(d) as paragraph 49 (b)</p>
