ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT
(CAP. 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY
SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC
PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Water Treatment Plant and Access Road) Order 2007.

Proposed construction declared to be a public work.

2. The proposed construction of a water treatment plant, access road and office buildings on the land described in the Schedule hereunder is hereby declared to be a public work.

Authorisation to enter and examine the land.

3. The Chief Work Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorized to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining the land with a view to acquisition of the whole or part of it for the proposed work.

All that area situate in the county of Berbice and bounded as follows-

On the North: by Lot 22 Section 'A' Pln. Cotton Tree, West Coast Berbice;


On the South: by Lot 19 Section 'A' Pln. Cotton Tree, West Coast Berbice;

On the East: Harban Spurn Dam Section 'A' Pln. Cotton Tree, West Coast Berbice;

On the West: by (School) Street Section 'A' Pln. Cotton Tree, West Coast Berbice.

The land is shown on a plan prepared by the Guyana Lands and Surveys Commission, located at 22 Upper Hadfield Street, Durban Backlands, Georgetown on record in that office as Plan No. COS 152 dated 28th June, 2006 by Mr N. Lui, Sworn Land Surveyor.
