**ORDER****Made Under****THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT  
(Cap 27:11)****IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF  
THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDER)  
ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-**

Citation and  
commencement

1. This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) Order\*, may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) Order 2004, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2004.

Amendment of Clause 6  
of the Principal Order.

2. Clause 6 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraphs (c) and (d) of the following paragraphs as paragraphs (c), (d) and (e) -

“(c) to the Chairman of the Public Service Commission, the Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission and the Chairman of the Police Service Commission a travelling allowance of \$9,504 per month;

- (d) to the Deputy Chairman of the Public Service Commission, the Deputy Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission a travelling allowances of \$6336 per month;
- (e) to every member of the Public Service Commission, the Police Service Commission and the Teaching Service Commission, other than the Chairmen a travelling allowance at the scale c rate subject to a mileage limit of one hundred miles”.

3. Clause 9 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution in paragraph 3 for the words “fifty dollars per month” of the words “one thousand dollars per month”.
