IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order which amends the Minimum Wages (Employees in Drug Stores) Order\*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Employees in Drug Stores) (Amendment) Order 1993 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st November, 1993.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects —

(a) in clause 2 —

(i) by the insertion of the following definition immediately before the definition of “clerk” —

“‘checker’ means a person who is employed to certify the accuracy of purchases against”; and

(ii) by the insertion of the following definition after the definition of “clerk” —

“‘driver’ means a person who is employed to drive a motor vehicle in connection with a drug store”.

(b) by the substitution for the schedule thereto of the schedule hereto.
