IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 10 OF THE MINING ACT, 1989, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: —

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (Prospecting for Gold and Valuable Minerals) Reservation Order 1995 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 15th day of May, 1995.

2. The area hereinafter described in the Schedule below is hereby reserved for prospecting operations by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission; but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission.

**SCHEDULE**

A tract of State Land situate on the Left Bank of the Mahdia River commencing at a point opposite the mouth of Carty Creek and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 1.5 miles.

Thence in a westerly direction for 2.75 miles.

Thence in a northerly direction for 2.5 miles.

Thence in an easterly direction along the bank of the said Mahdia River to the point of commencement enclosing altogether an area of five (5) square miles approximately. Save and except all lands already lawfully held or occupied.
