## THE LABOUR ACT

(Cap. 98:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order which amends the Minimum Wages (Cinema Employees) Order \*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Cinema Employees) (Amendment) Order 1996, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st March, 1996.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the Schedule thereto of the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

Category of Employee	Minimum Rate of Wages
Operator	\$2,708.00 per week
General Staff over 18 years	\$2,585.00 per week
General Staff under 18 years	\$2,093.00 per week
Cashier	\$2,093.00 per week
Clerical Assistant	\$2,093.00 per week
Ticket Collector	\$2,093.00 per week
Guard	\$2,093.00 per week
Sweeper or Cleaner	\$1,624.00 per week

The minimum rates of wages payable to a person employed during any period of time mentioned in this Schedule in more than one category of work set out above in respect of which different minimum rates of wages are set out, shall be the highest of such rates.

The minimum rates of wages payable to a person employed in any of the above categories of work for any shorter period of time than the appropriate period set out above shall be the appropriate minimum rate of wages set out above in respect of the last mentioned period.

Made this 25th day of March, 1996.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order makes provision for the payment of increased wages to cinema employees.
