**ORDER**

Made Under

**THE IMMIGRATION ACT  
(Cap. 14:02)**

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE IMMIGRATION ACT, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS HIM THEREUNTO ENABLING IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE PRESIDENT AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Alternative to Passports) Order 1992 and shall come into operation on 10th February, 1992.

2. In this Order —

tation.

(a) "Caribbean Community" means the community of States established by the Treaty signed on 4th July, 1973, at Chaguaramas;

(b) "driver's licence" means a driver's licence issued under the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act;

Cap. 19:08 (c) "identification card" means an identification card issued under the National Registration Act and includes a replacement identification card so issued.

Entry into Guyana of Caricom nationals without passports.

3. Subject to the provisions of this Order a person, being a national of one of the countries within the Caribbean Community mentioned in the Schedule, hereinafter referred to as a Caricom national, may enter Guyana without a passport on production to the immigration officer of —

(a) his driver's licence; or

(b) his identification card,

which must be valid and must clearly indicate his home address, nationality and contain his recent photograph.

Non-application of clause 3.

4. Clause 3 shall not apply to a Caricom national unless the law of the country to which that national belongs is such as to ensure entry of Guyanese and other Caricom nationals into that country on conditions substantially similar to those set out in this Order.
