**THE LOCAL DEMOCRATIC ORGANS ACT 1980**

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS  
9 AND 50 OF THE LOCAL DEMOCRATIC ORGANS ACT 1980, I  
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Local Democratic Organs (Emoluments of Office-holders) Order 1989\*, may be cited as the Local Democratic Organs (Emoluments of Office-holders) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1991 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1991.

### ERRATUM

The Immigration (Alternative to Passports) Order 1992, Order No. 4 of 1992, published in the Official Gazette, Legal Supplement — B on 14th February, 1992 —

(a) clause 1 should read —

“This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Alternative to Passports) (No. 2) Order 1992 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 10th February, 1992.”;

(b) clause 2(c) should read —

““identification card” means an identification card issued under the National Registration Act and includes a replacement identification card so issued or an identification card issued under the corresponding law of one of the countries mentioned in the Schedule.”’.
