THE IMMIGRATION ACT

(Cap. 14:02)

UNDER SECTION 12(7) OF THE IMMIGRATION ACT, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS HIM THEREUNTO ENABLING IT HEREBY ORDERED BY THE PRESIDENT AS FOL-LOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Grad-Citation: uates) Order 1992.

Free entry of graduates.

2. A person mentioned in paragraph (a) or (b) in Part A of the Schedule to the Act who is a national of a country mentioned in Part B of the said Schedule shall be permitted by an immigration officer to enter and remain in Guyana either for a definite or an undefinite period subject to the following conditions —

- (a) he must satisfy the requirement specified in the Immigration (Alternative to Passports) Order 1992 in relation to the production of his driver's licence or his identification card; or produce his passport to the immigration officer;
- (b) he must produce evidence satisfactory to the immigration officer that
 - (i) he is a graduate for the University of the West Indies or University of Guyana:
 - (ii) he is a national of a country mentioned in Part B of the Schedule to the Act;
- (c) he must inform the immigration officer of his intention to seek employment or to settle in Guyana.
