(REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Remuneration of Holders) (No. 2) Order 1992 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 8th July, 1991.

Every appointed member of the Public Service Commission other than the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman — Salary	\$108,000
Every appointed member of the Judicial Service Commission who is not a Judge of the Supreme Court of Judicature—Salary		\$ 96,000
Chairman of the Police Service Commission — Salary	\$384,000
Every appointed member of the Police Service Commission performing part-time duties with the Commission — Salary	\$ 96,000
Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission — Salary	\$384,000
Deputy Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission — Salary	\$192,000
Every appointed member of the Teaching Service Commission, other than the Chairman and Deputy Chairman, performing full-time duties with the Commission — Salary	\$132,000
Every appointed member of the Teaching Service Commission performing part-time duties with the Commission — Salary	\$ 96,000
