THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988

(No. 21 of 1988)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 AND 11 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, AS APPLIED TO SANATA TEXTILES LIMITED UNDER SECTION 66 OF THAT ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sanata Textiles Limited (Vesting of Property) Order 1992 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 17th August, 1992.

Citation and commencement.

2. In this Order —

Interpretation.

(a) "appointed day" means the day on which this Order is deemed to have come into operation.

(b) "Company" means the Sanata Textiles Limited, being a company incorporated under the Companies Act and owned by the State.

3. The item of immovable property of the State described in the Schedule and which is at present in the possession of the Company, is hereby vested in the Company.

H. Khan, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 18th February, 1975, and deposited in the Deeds Registry on the 7th day of August, 1975, and the said area "Y—1" being shown laid down and defined on a plan by F. M. Baksh, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 1st October, 1976 and deposited in the Deeds Registry at Georgetown on the 1st day of November, 1976 and transported to the Government of Guyana on 6th day of November, 1991 by transport No. 800 of 1991.
