IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order which amends the Minimum Wages (Employees in Drug Stores) Order 1984* may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Employees in Drug Stores) (Amendment) Order 1996, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st March, 1996.
