**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY
SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE
FOLLOWING ORDER:-**

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as trade (Control of Imports) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles with Tinted Glass) Order 1999.

Prohibition of imports.

2. No person shall import into Guyana after the 4th day of April 1999 any motor vehicle which has fitted to it any glass or safety glass, or any other material use in the place of such glass or safety glass, which is so tinted or otherwise treated or coloured, in such manner or to such extent, as would result in obstructing or in any other way preventing the identification of the driver of the motor vehicle or any other person travelling in the motor vehicle by any person from outside the motor vehicle.

Authority to inspect.

3. For the purpose of securing compliance with this Order the Competent Authority may enter and inspect any premises or place with a view of securing compliance with this Order.

Exemption.

4. The Minister may exempt a motor vehicle or motor vehicles of such class or description as he may think fit from the provisions of clause 2.
