

ORDER

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Chapter 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Offices for the Public Service Ministry) Order 1982.

2. The buildings and erections constructed or proposed to be constructed on the land described in the Schedule hereunder, is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part thereof for the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

Lot 63 High Street (known in the books of the Town Clerk as Lot number 16 (sixteen) or lot 63 (sixty-three) and formerly known on the Receiver's Books as number 55 (fifty-five) High Street, in Kingston District in the city of Georgetown, in the County of Demerara, Guyana, and bounded as follows:—

On the North:	By Lots 61 and 62 High Street
On the East:	By Lot 96 Duke Street
On the South:	By Lot 64 High Street
On the West:	By High Street.

The aforesaid land is shown on a plan prepared by Ministry of Agriculture, Kingston, Georgetown and on as Drawing No. BD 567 dated 1982-02-08. Survey Division, in that Division
