

## ORDER

## THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Chapter 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Buildings for Residential Purposes) Order 1982.
2. The proposed construction of residential buildings on the lands described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.
3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said lands for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such lands with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such lands for the public work aforesaid.

**SCHEDULE**

“Lots numbered 40, 52, 51, 54, 56, 58, 135, 137, 139, 152, 160, 183, 185, 211, 217, 232, 255, 271, 274, 287, 296, 305, 156, 162, 169, 171 and 196, being parts of a tract of land containing an area of 78.61 (seven eight decimal six one) acres, now known as Meadow Brook Gardens, part of Plantation Le Repentir, situate on the right bank of the Demerara River, in the County of Demerara, in Guyana, the said tract of land being laid down and defined on a plan by K. Muir, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 22nd November, 1965, and deposited in the Deeds Registry, Georgetown, on the 16th day of April, 1966, the said lots being shown and laid down on a plan by W. S. Taljit, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 22nd November, 1967, and deposited in the Deeds Registry, Georgetown, on the 25th day of April, 1968”.
