THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Buildings for Residential Purposes) Orders 1982 made on the 26th day of April, 1982, in relation to the lands specified in the Schedule hereto, the proposed construction of the buildings on the said lands was declared to be a public work in accordance with section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS by the same Orders the Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants, or workmen was authorised under section 4 of the said Act to enter upon the said lands for the purposes of surveying or otherwise examining such lands with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with section 6 of the said Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer and a plan of the lands to be acquired have been laid before the Minister;

NOW THEREFORE in accordance with section 6 of the said Act, it is hereby declared that the lands described in the Schedule to this Order are required for the Public work aforesaid.

THIS Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Buildings for Residential Purposes) Order 1982.

SCHEDULE

Parcels numbered 1479 (one thousand four hundred and seventy-nine), 1480 (one thousand four hundred and eighty), 1481 (one thousand four hundred and eighty-one), 1482 (one thousand four hundred and eighty-two) and 1483 (one thousand four hundred and eighty-three), Roxanne Burnham Gardens in Block XXX of Zone E.B.D., South Ruimveldt, Georgetown, Demerara.

Parcels numbered 1863 (one eight, six three), 1889 (one eight, eight nine), 2883 (two eight, eight three), 2888 (two eight, eight eight), 2892 (two eight, nine two), 2922 (two nine, two wo) in Block XXX of Zone E.B.D., North Ruimveldt, Georgetown, Demerara.

Lots 610 (six hundred and ten) and 623 (six hundred and twenty-three), East Ruimveldt, Greater Georgetown, Demerara.

Sub-lot 32 of lot 182, part of West Ruimveldt, Greater Georgetown, Demerara, Lot 53 East La Penitence, Georgetown, Demerara.

Lot numbered 21 (twenty-one) Lancaster Housing Scheme, East Coast, Demerara, Guyana.

Plot H, known as Car Park, part of Plantation Bel Air, now known as Prashad Nagar, Greater Georgetown.

Lots numbered 149, 156, 162, 169, 191, 196 and 197, being parts of Block 'C', a portion of a tract of Government Lands lying and being to the east of Lodge, in the City of Georgetown, in the county of Demerara, in the Republic of Guyana, the said Block and the said lots being shown laid down and defined on a plan by T. Singh, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 20th February, 1975, and deposited in the Deeds Registry at Georgetown, on the 13th day of May, 1975.

Lots numbered 40, 51, 52, 54, 56, 58, 135, 137, 139, 152, 160, 183, 185, 232, 255, 274, 287, 296 and 305, being parts of a tract of land containing an area of 78.61 (seven eight decimal six one) acres, now known as Meadow Brook Gardens, part of Plantation Le Repentir, situate on the right bank of the Demerara River, in the county of Demerara, in Guyana, the said tract of land being laid down and defined on a plan by K. Muir, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 22nd November, 1965, and deposited in the Deeds Registry, Georgetown, on the 16th day of April, 1966, the said lots being shown and laid down on a plan by W.S. Taljit, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 22nd November, 1967, and deposited in the Deeds Registry Georgetown, on the 25th day of April, 1968.
