THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Guyana State Corporation Development Complex) Order, 1977* made on the 11th July, 1977, the proposed construction for the extension of warehousing and wharfage facilities for the Guyana State Corporation on the lands described in the schedule to that Order was declared to be a public work in accordance with section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS, by the said Order the Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants or workmen was authorised under section 4 of the said Act to enter upon the said lands for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such lands with a view to the acquisition of the whole or a part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer and a plan of the lands to be acquired have been laid before the Minister;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the lands described in the schedule to this Order are required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Guyana State Corporation Development Complex) Order, 1980.

SCHEDULE

That portion of land containing approximately 19,428 sq. feet being part of the Charlestown Ward, situate in the City of Georgetown, Demerara, Guyana with the building and erections thereon and bounded as follows:

on the north by the southern boundary of mud lot 10, on the east by the western boundary of a tract of land 0.326 of an acre, on the south by the Old Canal Dam between Water Street and the Demerara River now vested in the Guyana National Engineering Corporation and on the west by the Demerara River. The aforesaid portion of land is shown on a plan by K.N. Maraj, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 28th November, 1977 on record at the Department of Lands and Surveys as Plan No. 17934.
