Made Under

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government Offices) Order, 1980* made on the 24th September, 1980 the proposed construction of Government Offices on the land described in the schedule to that Order was declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS, by the said Order the Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen was authorised under section 4 of the Act to enter upon the said land for the purposes therein mentioned;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer and a plan of the land with the buildings and erections thereon to be acquired were laid before the Minister;

AND WHEREAS, the Minister has deemed it advisable to declare that the said land together with the buildings and erections thereon is required for a public work;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land, together with the buildings and erections thereon, described in the schedule to this Order, is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government Offices) (No. 2) Order, 1980.

SCHEDULE

Sub-lot "C" being the Eastern Part of the West Half of Lots 272 and 273 Thomas and Lamaha Streets, situate in the North Cummingsburg District, in the City of Georgetown, in the County of Demerara, in the Republic of Guyana, together with the buildings and erections thereon, surveyed and defined on a plan by J. A. Rayman, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 15th November, 1980, and recorded on 18th November, 1980, at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Georgetown as Plan No. 19167.

The boundaries of the aforesaid Sublot "C" shown bordered red on the abovementioned plan, commence at a nail set in concrete base marked J. A. R. 147.5 feet West of the centre line of Thomas Street and 25.7 feet South of the centre line of Lamaha Street and proceed thence S $15^{\circ}40' 00''$ W (tr.) for a distance of 160.62 feet, thence N $74^{\circ}20' 00''$ E (tr.) for a distance of 48.75 feet, thence N $16^{\circ}06' 47''$ E (tr.) for a distance of 161.7 feet, thence S $73^{\circ}02' 43''$ E (tr.) for a distance of 47.49 feet, to the point of commencement and contain an area of 0.1780 acre.
