

ORDINANCE No. 7 OF 1915.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Law relating to the Registration of Veterinary Surgeons. A.D. 1915.

[27th February, 1915.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Court of Policy thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as The Veterinary Surgeons Ordinance, 1909, Amendment Ordinance, 1915. Short title.

Interpretation.

2. Section two of the Veterinary Surgeons Ordinance, 1909, is hereby repealed and the following section shall be deemed to be inserted in the said Ordinance in lieu thereof:—

2. In this Ordinance:—

“The Board” means the Veterinary Committee for the time being of the Board of Agriculture established under the Board of Agriculture Ordinance, 1910.

“The Secretary” means the Secretary of the Board of Agriculture established as aforesaid.

“Veterinary surgery” means the art and science of veterinary surgery and medicine.

3. The word “Medical” in sub-section (2) of section six, sub-section (1) of section seven, sub-section (2) of section eight, and in section ten, of the Veterinary Surgeons Ordinance, 1909, is hereby deleted.

4. Nothing herein contained shall be held to affect or impair any registration made in the Veterinary Surgeons' Register kept by the Secretary of the Medical Board under the provisions of the Veterinary Surgeons Ordinance, 1909, prior to the coming into force of this Ordinance, provided, however, that such Register shall after such date become part of the records of the Board and shall be retained in the custody of the Secretary thereof.
