

ORDINANCE No. 23 OF 1918.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Spirits Ordinance, 1905. A.D. 1918.

[27th July, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Court of Policy thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Spirits Ordinance, 1905, Amendment Ordinance, 1918, and shall be read as one with the Spirits Ordinance, 1905, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance, and any amending Ordinance. Short title

2. Sub-section (1) of section ninety-four of the principal Ordinance is amended by inserting a new sub-section (c), as follows:—
“(c) subjects any cask to any process for the purpose of extracting any spirits absorbed in the wood thereof or has on his premises any cask which is being subjected to any such process or any spirits extracted from the wood of any such cask; or”
and by re-numbering sub-section (c) as sub-section (d). Amendment of Sub-section (1) of Section 94 of Ord. 1 of 1905

3. Sub-section (2) of section ninety-four of the principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in the first line after the word “removed” and before the word “shall,” the following words “and every cask which is being subjected to any such process, or which being upon premises upon which spirits so extracted are found has been subjected to any such process.” Amendment of Sub-section (2) of Section 9 of Ord. 1 of 1905.
