

CHAPTER 54.

APPROPRIATION.

[No. XVIII of 1929.]

[23rd March, 1929.]

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1929. Short title.

2. The Treasurer of the colony shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the colony a sum not exceeding in the aggregate three million seven hundred and sixty-eight thousand and eighty-six dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the civil government of the colony and for other purposes during the year ending the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine. Treasurer to defray expenses of civil government.
