

CHAPTER 268.

FACTORIES (DANGEROUS TRADES
REGULATION.)

[No. V of 1891.]

[22nd April, 1891.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Factories (Dangerous Trades Regulation) Ordinance.

Interpreta-
tion.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires,—

“town” includes the city of Georgetown, and also any assemblage of houses and buildings which in the opinion of the Governor in Council can be properly described as a suburb of a town, or as a village; and, for the purposes of this Ordinance, the places called Albuoy’s town and the Lodge village shall respectively be deemed to be parts of the city of Georgetown;

“explosive or inflammable substance or thing” means any substance or thing which is defined as an explosive by the Explosives Ordinance, or is declared by order of the Governor in Council to be of an explosive or inflammable nature.

Chapter 74.

Prohibition
of factory for
manufacture
of explosives
in or near
town.

3.—(1) No one shall erect or begin to erect in a town, or within one quarter of a mile of the limits of a town, any factory or building whatever for the manufacture of any explosive or inflammable substance or thing.

Penalty.

(2) Everyone who contravenes this section shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty dollars for every day during which the erection is carried on, or during which the factory or building remains after it has been erected.

4.—(1) No one shall carry on in a factory or building situated in a town, or within one quarter of a mile of the limits thereof, the manufacture of any explosive or inflammable substance or thing.

(2) Everyone who contravenes this section shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty dollars for every day during which the contravention continues. Penalty.

(3) This section shall not apply to the manufacture of any explosive or inflammable substance or thing for the purpose of chemical experiment and not for practical use or sale.

5.—(1) The Governor and Legislative Council may from time to time make rules for the regulation of persons managing or employed in or about any factory or building used for the manufacture of any explosive or inflammable substance or thing, and generally for the regulation of that manufacture, with a view to secure the safety and proper discipline of those persons and the safety of the public. Rules for regulation of factory hands.

(2) There may be annexed to any contravention of any rule any penalty not exceeding fifty dollars deemed just.

6. All penalties incurred under this Ordinance or under any rules made thereunder may be sued for and recovered under the Summary Jurisdiction Ordinance by any commissary of taxation or police officer. Procedure and appeal.
