PROCLAMATION



By the President of the Co-
operative Republic of Guyana



PRESIDENT

WHEREAS a session of the Seventh Parliament of Guyana was summoned by proclamation dated 16th February, 1998, to be held on 26th February, 1998;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by article 70(2) of the Constitution that the President may at any time by proclamation dissolve Parliament;


AND WHEREAS by Section 9 of the Representation of the Peoples Act Cap.1:03, the Elections Commission shall by Notice published in the Gazette appoint a day not later than the 32nd day before Election Day on which Lists of Candidates may be submitted to the Chief Election Officer.

AND WHEREAS in pursuance of the Order of the Supreme Court of Judicature, in Action numbered 36-P of 1998, entered on 2nd February 2001, Parliament shall stand dissolved by nomination day:

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by the aforesaid article, I do hereby dissolve the Seventh Parliament of Guyana on 15th February 2001, or such other date that may be directed by Order of Court, whichever is the later.
