WHEREAS by Proclamation under the hand of the Governor and the Public Seal of the Colony dated 23rd December, 1964, issued under paragraph (1) of article 67 of the Constitution of British Guiana, Thursday, the 31st day of December, 1964, was appointed the day on which a session of the House of Assembly should commence;

AND WHEREAS a session of the said House commenced on the said day;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of article 68 of the Constitution of British Guiana that the Governor, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may at any time, by proclamation published in the Gazette, prorogue the Legislature:

NOW THEREFORE, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I do hereby prorogue the Legislature with effect from Saturday, the 21st day of May, 1966.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Government House, British Guiana, this 17th day of May, 1966, and in the fifteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
