

PROCLAMATION



By the President of the **Co-operative Republic** of Guyana.

L. F. S. Burnham. President.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 56 of the Local Democratic Organs Act 1980, that section 42 of the said Act applies mutatis mutandis to the filing of casual vacancies amongst members of the National Assembly who were elected by a Council;

AND WHEREAS by virtue of sections 42(2) and 56 of the said Act, any vacancy amongst members of the National Assembly who were elected by a council shall be filled by such other member of that council as is not a member of the National Assembly but is qualified for election as such a member and is elected as such a member by the council on such day as the President may by proclamation appoint, being a day which the President considers to be as early as practicable after the vacancy occurred. vacancy occurred;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the provisions of the said sections 42 and 56, I hereby appoint the thirteenth day of November, 1984, as the day on which the election shall be held by the Regional Democratic Council, Region No. 9 (Upper Takutu/Upper Essequibo) to fill the vacancy amongst members of the National Assembly who were elected by the council by the council.
