PROCLAMATION



By the President of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana

PRESIDENT

WHEREAS it is provided by article 61 of the Constitution that an election of members of the National Assembly under article 60(2) thereof shall be held on such day within three months after every dissolution of Parliament as the President shall appoint by Proclamation;

AND WHEREAS by Proclamation of the President dated 8th February, 2001, Parliament shall be dissolved on 15th February, 2001 or such other date that may be directed by Order of Court, whichever is the later.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by the aforesaid article 61, I do hereby appoint the 19th March, 2001, as the day on which an election of members of the National Assembly under the said article 60(2) shall be held.

Given under my hand and the Seal of Guyana at the Office of the President, Georgetown, Guyana, this 8th day of February, Two Thousand and One in the thirty-first year of the Republic.
