

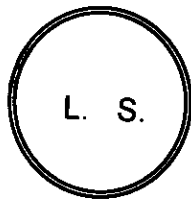

**PROCLAMATION**

By the President of the  
Cooperative Republic of Guyana

**PRESIDENT**

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2001, issued under article 70(2) of the Constitution, the Seventh Parliament of Guyana was dissolved on 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2001;

AND WHEREAS, it is provided by article 69(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Guyana and shall begin at such time, not being later than four months from the end of the preceding session if Parliament has been dissolved, as the President shall appoint by proclamation;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of article 69(1) of the Constitution, I do hereby appoint the Parliament Chambers, Public Buildings, Georgetown, Guyana as the place where a session of the Eighth Parliament shall be held as aforesaid at 2 o'clock in the afternoon of 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2001, as the time when such session shall begin.
