PROCLAMATION

L.S.

By His Excellency SIR EDWARD VICTOR LUCKHOO, Queen's Counsel, Acting Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Guyana.

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated 18th February, 1970, issued under article 82(1) of the Constitution of Guyana (hereinafter referred to as "the Constitution"), the Parliament of Guyana will be prorogued with effect from Saturday the 21st February, 1970;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by article 81(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Guyana and shall begin at such time (not being later than six months from the end of the preceding session if Parliament has been prorogued) as the Governor-General shall appoint by proclamation:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of article 81(1) of the Constitution, and by virtue and in exercise of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby proclaim that a session of Parliament shall be held in the Parliament Chamber at the Public Buildings, Georgetown, Guyana, and shall begin at 10.00 o'clock in the forenoon on Monday, 23rd February, 1970.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Guyana at Guyana House, Georgetown, Guyana, this 18th day of February, 1970, and in the nineteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
