THE BAUXITE (PRODUCTION LEVY) ACT 1974

(No. 29 of 1974)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 14 OF THE BAUXITE (PRODUCTION LEVY) ACT 1974, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Bauxite (Restriction on Exportation) Regulations 1974, and shall come into operation forthwith. Citation and commencement.
2. In these Regulations — Interpretation
“Comptroller” means the Comptroller of Customs and Excise and includes an officer of the Department of Customs and Excise;
“export” means to take or cause to be taken out of Guyana.
3. Except with the permission of the Minister, where a bauxite producer is in default of payment of the production levy (including any provisional quarterly payment) which is due and payable under the Act to the Commissioner by the bauxite producer, no calcined bauxite or chemical grade bauxite won or extracted in Guyana by the bauxite producer shall be exported by any person whomsoever. Restriction on exportation of bauxite in default of payment of production levy
4. It shall be lawful for the Comptroller, or the Commissioner, or any member of the Police Force, or any other person authorised in writing in that behalf by the Minister, to enter, or board, and inspect any premises or vessel, as the case may be, with a view to securing compliance with these Regulations. Entry on premises.

Production

5. For the purpose of securing compliance with these Regulations, the bauxite producer or any person employed in the undertaking carried on by the bauxite producer shall produce to any person mentioned in regulation 4 such books, accounts or other documents relating to the undertaking as any such person may require, from time to time.

Offences

6. Any person who obstructs or impedes any person mentioned in regulation 4 in the exercise of his functions under regulation 4, or refuses or fails to produce any book, account or other document which that person is required to produce under regulation 5, shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of ten thousand dollars.
