Made Under

BROADCASTING ACT 2011

(Act No. 17 of 2011)

IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 40 AND 48 OF THE BROADCASTING ACT 2011 AND AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD AND THE NATIONAL FREQUENCY MANAGEMENT UNIT UNDER SECTION 48, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

- Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Broadcasting Regulations 2014.
- Application for a broadcasting licence. Schedule. 2. Application for the issue of a broadcasting licence shall be made to the Authority in Form A in the Schedule and to which shall be attached an application fee of fifteen thousand dollars and, in the case of an existing broadcaster under the Post and Telegraph Act, the wireless telegraphy licence issued under that Act.

- Broadcasting licence fee to continue a broadcasting service. 3. For the grant of a broadcasting licence to continue a broadcasting service an existing broadcaster shall pay to the Authority an annual fee equivalent to 3.5 percent of the previous year's revenue or two million, five hundred thousand dollars, whichever is greater.

4. For the grant of a broadcasting licence to commence a broadcasting service an applicant shall pay a fee of two million, five hundred thousand dollars and annually after that payment, the fee prescribed for an existing broadcaster under regulation 3.

5. The form of a broadcasting licence shall be in Form B in the Schedule.

6. The Broadcasting Regulations 2013** are revoked.
