THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT

(Cap. 47:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS :—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Insured Boxes Regulations<sup>Citation,</sup>, may be cited as the Insured Boxes (Amendment) Regulations 1989.

2. Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution, for all the words beginning with "To secure compensation up to \$57.60" and ending with "\$115.20" where the latter words occur for the second time of the words <sup>Amendment of regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations.</sup>

"To secure compensation up to \$100.00 ..... \$5.00.

To secure compensation up to \$200.00 ..... \$10.00.  
and a sum of \$8.00 additional for every \$100.00 or part of \$100.00 up to \$1,000.00".
