REGULATIONS

THE TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS ACT

(Cap. 49:04)

UNDER SECTION 49 OF THE TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS ACT, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GENERAL MANAGER, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER:

1. These Regulations, which amend the Transport and Harbours Department (Superannuation and other Benefits) Regulations*, may be cited as the Transport and Harbours Department (Superannuation and other Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 1979. Citation

2. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects:— Amendment of Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations.

- (a) by renumbering paragraph (2) as paragraph (3) thereof; and
- (b) by inserting the following paragraph as paragraph (2) —

“(2) (a) In computing the pension, annual allowance or gratuity of any employee under paragraph (1), a period of service of an employee in a pensionable office within the meaning of the Pensions Act, or in an appointment other than a pensionable office, or of service paid for out of an open vote, or of both such services, or any part of such period, may be taken into account by the General Manager:

Provided that where the period of service of an employee which may be taken into account by virtue of the foregoing provisions of this paragraph did not immediately precede service in the Department, that period of service may not be taken into account by the General Manager, except with the approval of the Minister.

- (b) The provisions of this paragraph shall apply to a person who is an employee in the Department at or after the commencement of this paragraph and whether or not the Service which may be taken into account under this paragraph was given prior to such commencement.
