REGULATIONS

Made Under

The Customs Act

(Cap. 82:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 275 OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise Department (Uniform and Equipment) Regulations 1979.

2. Uniforms and equipment shall be issued to a person serving in the Customs and Excise Department in accordance with the Schedules.

3. A person to whom uniforms and equipment are issued in accordance with these Regulations shall as far as possible during the performance of his duties utilize the uniforms and equipment.

4. A waterguard may wear ornaments applicable to his section of the Department.

5. Uniforms and equipment remain the property of the Government and shall be returned to the stores when a person leaves the service of the Department or on the request of the Comptroller.

6. Uniforms and equipment issued shall be recorded by the storekeeper who shall take receipts for all issues and upon their return to him the storekeeper shall record the particulars thereof in the presence of the person returning the articles.

7. A person when proceeding on vacation **leave**, absent from duty for any period in excess of one **calendar** shall return to the store-keeper his uniforms and equipment for safe **keeping**.

8. Where the certificate of the store-keeper discloses deficiency in the articles returned by a person the **equal** value of the deficiency may be deducted from any **money** available to that person.

9. The Customs and Excise Department (Uniform **Equipment**) Regulations, 1972, are hereby revoked.
