THE LABOUR ACT

(Cap. 98:01)

UNDER SECTION 28 OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations, which amend the Hours of Work (Employees at Petrol Stations) Regulations 1977, may be cited as the Hours of Work (Employees at Petrol Stations) (Amendment) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 21st July, 1978.

Revocation and replacement of regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution of the following regulation for regulation 3 there-  
of —

“Normal hours of work for an employee

3. (1) The number of hours which may normally be worked by an employee employed on a daily or hourly basis shall not exceed eight in any day.

(2) The number of hours which may normally be worked by an employee employed otherwise than on a daily or hourly basis shall not exceed forty-eight in any week.”
