THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT 1977

(No. 10 of 1977)

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 41 OF THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT, 1977 THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE —
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Maritime Boundaries (Fishery Zone Fees) Regulations 1977.
 - 2 In these Regulations
 - "owner" in relation to a fishing boat includes the person having for the time being the principal charge and care of such fishing hoat
- 3. There shall be paid to the Chief Agriculture Officer by the owner of a flahing boat referred to in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the period expiring one year from the date of payment the fee set out, respectively, in the second column against the reference to such boat.
- 4. On receiving payment, the Chief Agriculture Officer shall issue a receipt therefor specifying
 - (a) the date of payment:
 - (b) the amount paid, and
 - (c) the name of the fishing boat in respect of which payment was made together with such other particulars as would tend to the ready identification of that boat.

5 Any owner of a fishing boat who fails to make payment of the fee payable by him under regulation 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of ten thousand dollars and to imprisonment for six months.
