Made Under

THE CUSTOMS ACT

(Cap. 82:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 275 OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Customs Regulations*, may be cited as the Customs (Amended) Regulations 1991. Citation.

2. Form C14 in Schedule B to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows —

Amendment of Schedule B to the Principal Regulations.

(a) by the substitution for paragraph 10 of the following paragraph —

- (b) by the insertion at the end of the instructions of the following paragraph —

“Any person may bring into Guyana any amount of foreign currency providing he makes a declaration in respect of amounts in excess of US \$10,000 (ten thousand) United States dollars or its equivalent.”
