THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE
DIRECTOR OF POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS WITH THE
APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL :—

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Linemen (Revocation) Regulations, 1967.

(2) These Regulations shall come into force upon the coming into operation of the Guyana Telecommunication Corporation Order, 1967.

2. The Regulations for Linemen* made by the Postmaster General and approved by the Governor and Court of Policy on the 17th October, 1889, are hereby revoked.
