GUYANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE GUYANA CITIZENSHIP ACT, 1967.

UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE GUYANA CITIZENSHIP ACT, 1967, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE BY THE MINISTER :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Guyana Citizenship Regulations, 1967.
2. In these Regulations —
“schedule” means a schedule to these Regulations;
“the Act” means the Guyana Citizenship Act, 1967;
“the Constitution” means the Constitution of Guyana.

PART I

Citizenship by Registration

3. An application by a woman for registration as a citizen of Guyana under paragraph (1) or (4) of Article 22 of the Constitution or under Article 25 of the Constitution shall be made to the Minister in the form set out as Form R1 in the first schedule; and the oath of allegiance required to be taken by an applicant who is a British protected person or an alien shall be subscribed and attested, and as so subscribed and attested shall be included in the form of application.
4. An application for registration as a citizen of Guyana under paragraph (2) of Article 22 of the Constitution shall be made to the Minister in the form set out as Form R2 in the first schedule.
5. An application for registration as a citizen of Guyana under paragraph (3) of Article 22 of the Constitution shall be made to the Minister in the form set out as Form R3 in the first schedule.
6. (1) An application for registration as a citizen of Guyana under section 4(1) of the Act shall be made in the form set out as Form R4 in the first schedule.
(2) An application for registration as a citizen of Guyana under subsection (2) of section 4 of the Act shall be made in writing

addressed to the appropriate authority specified in regulation 8 of these Regulations and shall include the following information, that is to say —

- (a) in the case of any application, sufficient information to satisfy the authority to whom the application is made that the person in respect of whom it is made is and always has been stateless and is qualified for registration under the said subsection (2);
- (b) in the case of an application made in respect of a minor by his parent or guardian, a statement whether the applicant is a parent or guardian of the minor, and, if he is a guardian, how he became a guardian.

7. An application for registration of a minor child of a citizen of Guyana as a citizen of Guyana under subsection (1) of section 5 of the Act shall be made to the Minister in the form set out as Form R5 in the first schedule.

8. An application made by or on behalf of a person entitled to be registered as a citizen of Guyana under the Constitution shall be made —

- (a) if the applicant is at the time of his application resident in a country in which there is a representative of the Government of Guyana, to that representative;
- (b) if the applicant is at the time of his application resident in a country in which there is no representative of the Government of Guyana, to such person authorised by the Minister and serving in the diplomatic, consular or other foreign service of any country which, by arrangement with the Government of Guyana, has undertaken to represent that Government's interests;
- (c) in any other case, to the Minister.

PART II

Naturalisation

9. An application for a certificate of naturalisation shall be made in the form set out as Form N1 in the first schedule.

10. A certificate of naturalisation granted by the Minister shall be in the form set out in the second schedule and shall be signed by the Minister or by a person authorised by him in that behalf.

11. (1) The oath of allegiance required by section 9 of the Act to be taken by a person to whom a certificate or naturalisation has been granted shall be endorsed on the certificate of naturalisation to which it relates.

(2) The oath of allegiance required as aforesaid shall be taken within one month of the date of the certificate of naturalization to which it relates, or within such extended time as the Minister may permit, and if the oath is not taken within the said time the certificate shall have no effect:

Provided that permission shall not be deemed to have been given under this paragraph unless a statement to that effect is endorsed on the certificate and signed by a person authorised by regulation 10 of these Regulations to sign a certificate of naturalisation.

(3) The oath of allegiance required as aforesaid shall be registered at the office of the Minister.

PART III

Renunciation and Deprivation of Citizenship of Guyana.

12. (1) A declaration of renunciation of citizenship of Guyana made under subsection (1) of section 10 of the Act shall be in the form set out in the third schedule.

(2) The declaration shall, subject to the provisions of the said section 10, be registered at the office of the Minister.

13. (1) When it is proposed to make an order under section 11 of the Act depriving a person of his citizenship of Guyana the notice required by subsection (4) of section 11 thereof to be given to that person may be given —

- (a) in the case where that person's whereabouts are known, by causing the notice to be delivered to him personally or by sending it to him by registered post;
- (b) in the case where that person's whereabouts are not known, by sending it to his last known address and by publication in the Gazette.

(2) Where the Minister has given notice as aforesaid, any application for an enquiry under subsection (5) of section 11 of the Act shall be made —

- (a) if that person is in Guyana at the time when the notice is given to him, within twenty-one days from the giving of the notice;
- (b) in any other case, within such time, not being less than twenty-one days from the giving of the notice, as the Minister may determine:

Provided that the Minister may in special circumstances at any time extend the time within which the application may be made.

(3) Any notice given in accordance with the provisions of this regulation shall include a statement of the time within which application for an enquiry under subsection (5) of section 11 of the Act must be made.

14. Where an order has been made depriving a person who is a citizen of Guyana by registration of that citizenship, his name shall be removed from the register of citizens of Guyana in which it is entered.

15. Where an order has been made depriving a person naturalised in Guyana of his citizenship of Guyana, the person so deprived or any other person in possession of the relevant certificate of naturalisation shall, if required by notice in writing given by the Minister, deliver up the said certificate to the Minister, or to such person, and within such time as may be specified in the notice, and the said certificate shall thereupon be cancelled or amended.

16. Where the preceding provisions of these Regulations require that an application or declaration shall be made, or a notice shall be given, in a form set out in a schedule, that requirement shall be treated as satisfied if the application or declaration is made or the notice is given —

- (a) in a form to the like effect; or
- (b) in a form authorised by the Minister or other authority to whom the application or declaration is made or the notice is given, if in the opinion of the Minister or that other authority, as the case may be, the form set out in the appropriate schedule is unsuitable in the circumstances of a particular case.

17. A certificate of citizenship in case of doubt given under section 12 of the Act shall be signed by the Minister or by a person authorised by him in that behalf.

18. Any application or declaration made in accordance with regulation 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9 or 12 of these Regulations shall not be accepted or registered, and the oath of allegiance required by Articles 22 and 25 of the Constitution, and section 9 of the Act shall be of no effect unless it is signed in the presence of or administered by one of the following persons —

- (a) in Guyana
 - any Magistrate, Justice of the Peace or Notary Public or any person authorised by law to administer oaths:
- (b) elsewhere —
 - any consular officer of the Government of Guyana or any consular officer of Her Majesty's Government

in the United Kingdom acting on behalf of the Government of Guyana or, if there is no such consular officer, any person authorised by the Government of Guyana in that behalf, or any person for the time being authorised by law, in the place where the applicant, declarant or deponent is, to administer oaths:

Provided that if the applicant, declarant or deponent is serving in the Guyana Defence Force the application or declaration may be signed in the presence of, or the oath administered by, any officer holding a commission in that Force, whether the application, declaration or oath is made or taken in Guyana or elsewhere.

19. A document may be certified to be a true copy of a document for the purpose of subsection (2) of section 13 of the Act by means of a statement in writing to that effect signed by a person authorised by the Minister in that behalf.

20. (1) Subject to the provisions of this regulation, the fees specified in the fourth schedule may be taken and shall be paid to the Accountant General.

(2) Of the fee payable in respect of the grant of a certificate of naturalisation, ten dollars (if the applicant is a British protected person) or fifteen dollars (if the applicant is an alien) shall be payable on the submission of the application for a certificate and shall in no circumstances be returned, and the balance shall be payable on the receipt of the decision to grant a certificate:

Provided that where a husband and wife apply at the same time for certificates and are residing together at the time of the applications and the balance is paid in respect of the grant of a certificate to one of them, no balance shall be payable in respect of the grant of a certificate to the other:

Provided further that the fee paid in respect of any application made under the British Nationality Act, 1948, before the 26th May, 1966, in respect of any application for registration or naturalisation which was not granted or refused before the commencement of these Regulations shall, if the applicant so desires, be deemed to be paid in respect of an application under these Regulations, or if the applicant does not desire to be considered as an applicant under these Regulations, be returned to him.

21. The Minister shall cause registers to be established and maintained and all matters required by the Constitution, the Act or these Regulations to be registered shall be entered in the appropriate register.

THE GUYANA CITIZENSHIP REGULATIONS, 1967.

(Regulation 3)
