REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 261).

UNDER SECTION 49(2) OF THE TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GENERAL MANAGER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Home Trade Ships (Masters, Mates and Engineers Certificates) (Amendment) Regulations, 1967, and shall be construed and read as one with the Home Trade Ships (Masters) Mates and Engineers Certificates) Regulations\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after Regulation 1 of the following new regulation —

'1A. In these Regulations —

“Minister” means the Minister for the time being charged with responsibility for Communications.

3. Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (2) and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph —

“(2) Every certificate to be awarded by the Board shall be in duplicate and be signed by the Minister and the Chief Examiner. The duplicate portions shall be kept by the Harbour Master together with a record of all certificates granted under these regulations.”
