REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION ACT, 1967,  
(No. 24 of 1967)

UNDER SECTION 19 OF THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION ACT, 1967,  
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE  
MINISTER:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Registration (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the National Registration Regulations 1968\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and all amendments thereto.

2. Regulation 26 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution of a full stop for the colon at the end of sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (1) and the deletion of the proviso thereto;
- (b) by the substitution for the words “notice to a person whose registration he intends to cancel under sub-paragraph (b), (c) or (d) of paragraph (1) of this regulation”, in paragraph (3), of the words “to every individual, being a person whose registration he intends to cancel under sub-paragraph (b), (c) or (d) of paragraph (1) of this regulation, notice”.
