THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (ADAPTATION AND MODIFICATION OF LAWS) ACT, 1968.

(No. 16 of 1968)

UNDER SECTION 3(1) (d) OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (ADAPTATION AND MODIFICATION OF LAWS) ACT, 1968, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Representation of the People (Adaptation and Modification of Laws) (No. 4) Regulations, 1968.

2.(1) The following amendments to the Election Regulations, 1964, are hereby prescribed for the purposes of section 3 of the Representation of the People (Adaptation and Modification of Laws) Act, 1968, that is to say —

(a) the addition of the following paragraph to regulation 43 H —

“(3) A ballot officer may exercise any powers, and perform any duties, of a ballot attendant under any provisions of Part VB and references in any such provisions to a ballot attendant shall be construed accordingly with such modifications to the context as may be necessary for the purpose.”;

(b) the deletion of the words “not later than two days before election day” from paragraph (2) of regulation 61.

(2) Sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) of this regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on 15th November, 1968.
