REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE COLONIAL MEDICAL SERVICE ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 134)

UNDER SECTION 52 OF THE COLONIAL MEDICAL SERVICE ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE MEDICAL BOARD :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sicknurses and Dispensers (Training and Examination) Regulations, 1969 and shall be construed and read as one with the Sicknurses and Dispensers (Training and Examination) Regulations, *hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and all amendments thereto.

2. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (a) by the renumbering of the regulation as paragraph (1); and
- (b) by the insertion of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) — “(2) For the purposes of carrying out the provisions of paragraph (1) of this regulation, the Board may appoint any person as a lecturer and for delivering a lecture, that person shall be paid ten dollars.”

3. Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (a) by the renumbering of the regulation as paragraph (1); and
- (b) by the insertion of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) — “(2) For the purposes of carrying out the provisions of paragraph (1) of this regulation, the Board may appoint any person as an examiner and that person shall be paid —
 - (1) for marking a written examination, fifteen dollars;
 - (2) for conducting an oral examination, fifteen dollars; and
 - (3) for supervising a practical examination, ten dollars.”

4. The Sicknurses and Dispensers (Training and Examination) Regulations, 1961** are hereby revoked.
