LEGAL SUPPLEMENT - B

GUYANA

REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE CUSTOMS ACT (Cap. 82:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 275 OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

Citation.

1. These Regulations which amend the Customs Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations 2007.

Amendment of regulation 84 of the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 84 of the Principal Regulations is amended by the substitution for the full stop at the end of the colon and by the insertion of the following proviso -

“Provided that for the period beginning on 1st February, 2007 and ending on 30th June, 2007 declarations in relation to the particulars required shall be in Forms C14B and C14C.”

Amendment of regulation 86 of the Principal Regulations.

3. Regulation 86 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows -

(a) by the substitution for the words “including cigars and cigarettes, not exceeding two hundred and twenty seven grams in the aggregate” of the words “not exceeding two hundred and fifty grams, cigarettes not exceeding two hundred, cigars not exceeding fifty or cigarillos not exceeding one hundred.”;

(b) by the substitution for the words “US \$100” of the words “US \$200”;

(c) by the insertion immediately after the fourth paragraph of the following paragraph -

“Perfume and toilet water each not exceeding two hundred and fifty millilitres.”

Amendment of Schedule B to the Principal Regulations.

4. Schedule B to the Principal Regulations is amended by the insertion after Form C14A of the following forms -
